

Title: Limited Term Lecturer, Entomology**Job Summary**

The Department of Entomology is seeking applications for a Limited Term Lecturer. LTL positions are temporary, non-benefits eligible, part-time positions hired each semester on an as-needed basis.

The **Primary Responsibilities** of successful candidates will be to:

- Teach on campus and/or online lower-level courses in introductory Entomology and upper-level courses in insect pest management.
- Maintain office hours and provide feedback to students in a timely manner.
- Maintain FERPA certification.
- Assist with program-related duties and administrative tasks, including orientation, proctoring, student evaluations, curriculum and program review.
- Understand and adhere to university policies and guidelines.
- Have competency in effective and appropriate online (synchronous and asynchronous) delivery and in-person instruction.

The qualified candidate will teach two 3-credit courses in the fall of 2024: ENTM 20600 (2 cr. lecture)/20700 (1 cr. lab) General Entomology and ENTM 41000 (3 cr.) Applied Insect Biology.. The LTL will have responsibility for lectures and laboratory sections, as well as grading student assignments. Support for ENTM 20700 laboratory sections will be provided by the department of Entomology instructions Specialist.

- Master's degree in Entomology or a related field
- Strong interpersonal, presentation, and written and verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrated experience teaching at the college level or relevant professional experience.
- Demonstrated ability to communicate both orally and in writing in English.
