Methods


- Spring, 2013

- 101 of 350 individuals responded (29% response rate)

12% had a K-12 teaching license






In the past academic year (2011-2012), have you interacted with PK-12 audiences in a scholarly or professional role?







Number of Times Faculty & Staff Used Their Expertise to Serve the Needs of PK-12 Audiences (2011-2012 Academic Year)






As an employee of a land-grant university, to what extent do you feel committed to contribute to communities across the state?









Where Faculty & Staff Engaged With PK-12 Audiences

How have you shared your PK-12 Engagement activities in an academic setting?






Examining Institutional Support for PK-12 Engagement






Examining Institutional Support for PK-12 Engagement

Examining Support for PK-12 Engagement




Value placed on PK-12 Engagement by Department's promotion and tenure...


Did you have engagement experiences with PK-12 students as a graduate student?

What changes could be made at the College level to help you engage with PK-12 audiences more effectively?




Of the 54 people who responded

- 4 said <u>rewards</u>


