Brief Biography

Dr. Keeney's research program is centered on U.S. farm, conservation, and energy policies. Recent work has focused in the areas of distribution of policy benefits and the producer response to policy influenced incentives. Dr. Keeney's analysis of policy and agriculture bridges the spectrum of policy implementation from international negotiations in agriculture trade to community planning and its influence on confined animal feeding.
