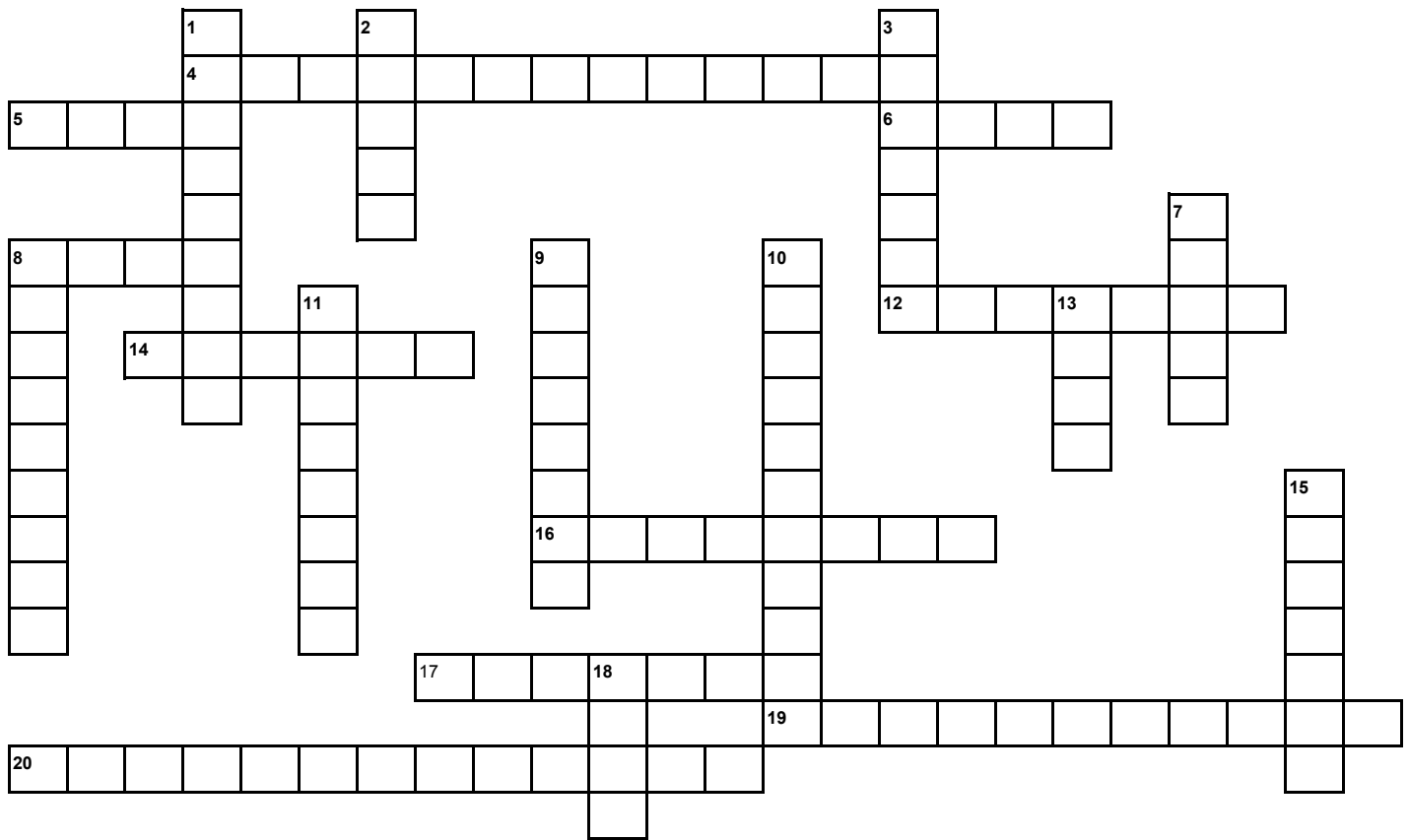


# OUR EARTH
