## 81st IBEP BULL SALE SUMMARY

### High Average Price for IBEP

A nice crowd was on hand at the Springville Feeder Auction on Thursday, April 19 for the 81<sup>st</sup> IBEP Bull Sale. Over 100 buyers from several states registered to bid on 88 top quality bulls representing six breeds. In addition, the sale was broadcast live via the internet by DVAuction Services. Two remote sites in Indiana viewed the sale, plus additional viewers throughout the U.S.

Bulls were in high demand and bidding was brisk. The sale average was \$3,132, which is the sixth highest sale average for IBEP, and all but nine bulls sold. Auctioneer Mike Berger, Bremen, IN topped the sale with the 1<sup>st</sup> bull in the ring.

SimAngus bull #93 topped the sale at \$6,500. Bull #93 was consigned by Neal Brothers Simmentals, Bicknell, IN and sired by J Bar J Nightride 225Z. His Performance Index was 121.2, with a Carcass Merit Index of 115.6 and adjusted intramuscular fat of 6.07%. His EPDs were in the top 10% of the breed for marbling and API and TI indexes, and in the top 20% for weaning weight, yearling weight, direct calving ease, carcass weight, and ribeye area.

There were several other high-selling bulls. Angus #185 sold for \$5,800. He was consigned by KB Angus, Merritt, MI and sired by Plattermere Weigh Up K360.

Angus #7 sold for \$5,700. He was consigned by Bill Washburn, Olney, IL and sired by Hoover Dam.

Angus #84 sold for \$5,100. He was consigned by Trietsch Farms LLC, Atlanta, IN and sired by WR Journey-1X74.

Two bull sold for \$4,900. Angus #5 was consigned by Bill Washburn and sired by Quaker Hill Rampage 0A36. Angus #155 was consigned by Way View Cattle Co., Hebron, OH and sired by Barstow Bankroll B73.

Angus #138 sold for \$4,800. He was consigned by Kiata Farms, Hamilton, OH and sired by Deer Valley All In.

Angus #184 sold for \$4,750. He was consigned by KB Angus and sired by Plattermere Weigh Up K360.

Angus #142 sold for \$4,100. He was consigned by Kiata Farms and sired by VF Ottawa 505.

Angus #55 sold for \$4,000. He was consigned by Stewart Select Angus, Greensburg, IN and sired by Connealy Cool 39L.

Four bulls sold for \$3,900. Simmental #4 was consigned by Bill Washburn and sired by HILB Oracle C033R. Angus #106 was consigned by Alexander Cattle Co., Covington, IN and sired by SAV Bismarck 5682. Simmental #108 was consigned by Knapper Cattle, Kingman, IN and sired by LLSF Pays to Believe ZU194. Angus #161 was consigned by Eagle River Angus, Princeville, IL and sired by VAR Discovery 2240.

Of the 88 bulls offered, 79 sold for an average of \$3,132. Seven went to buyers at the remote sites, and seven to other internet buyers. Bulls were purchased by 60 individuals from three states; 74 bulls were sold to Indiana buyers, four to Kentucky, and one to Illinois.

On the tables below, note high-selling bulls of each breed and their consignor. Also, the number sold, average, and top for 57 auctions held at Springville, and the number sold and averages for each breed.

The 2018 Summer Performance Test began with delivery on Tuesday, May 1. The 82<sup>nd</sup> IBEP Bull Sale will be held on Saturday afternoon, October 20, 2018 at the Springville Feeder Auction. The sale will be held in conjunction with the Springville Feeder Auction Association's Cow and Heifer Sale. Cows will begin selling at 2:00 pm, and bulls will sell immediately following. Be watching for details in the future.

<b>Tues., June 19</b>	Record 28-day weights; brucella retest on out-of-state bulls.
<b>Tues., July 24</b>	Record 63-day weights; adjusted 205-day data and registration numbers due; final payment due; ultrasound older bulls.
<b>Tues., August 21</b>	Record 91-day weights.
<b>September 17-21</b>	Ultrasound younger bulls (date TBA).
<b>Mon., September 24</b>	Record off-test weights; measure hip height and scrotal circumference; TB injection.
<b>Thurs., September 27</b>	Breeding soundness evaluation; freeze brand; read TB test.
<b>Sat., October 20</b>	82 <sup>nd</sup> IBEP Bull Sale and Springville Feeder Auction Association's Cow and Heifer Sale. Cows begin selling at 2:00 pm; the Bull Sale will follow.
