**Pumpkin Fungicide Schedule (December 2021)** - Start applications for bacterial spot at softball stage unless lesions observed earlier. Initial applications for Phytophthora blight, if needed, will depend on weather and field history-Phytophthora blight can affect seedlings. Start powdery mildew applications at bush stage. Most products from list D also are effective against downy mildew-don't make extra applications for downy mildew unless disease threatens. See *Midwest Vegetable Production Guide* (ID-56). Be sure to alternate FRAC codes. Read label! Numbers after products: (REI/PHI-FRAC code).
