

AGRICULTURAL BOOKS.

In view of the present status of the agricultural industry, of the ever changing conditions under which it is carried on, and because of the apparent necessity for a better understanding of the simple scientific principles which underlie practical agriculture and improved methods in farm practice, there is an increasing demand for the best and latest literature on farming. The assistance of the newest and most authoritative writings on agriculture are a necessity to the modern farmer if he would be successful in his business. The desire for enlightenment and information on various farm problems is more and more manifest as time goes on. Numerous inquiries from librarians, school officials, farmers and others for lists of good books on agriculture are coming into the office of the Agricultural Extension Department constantly. To meet this demand the following list of books has been prepared, and is hereby submitted to those interested in this class of literature.

The attention of those in charge of arranging Corn Club Contests, Corn Shows, School Contests, etc., is hereby called to the fact, that it is in this state a generally recognized fact that premiums of permanent interest and value, such as good books suitable to the age, understanding and environment of prize winners, are desirable rather than premiums of temporary and passing interest and value. Books appearing in this list carry with them the approval and recommendation of the different departments of the School of Agriculture and Experiment Station for all purposes named in this circular.

Sample copies of nearly all of the books here listed are included in the Extension Department's specimen library of agricultural books. This library accompanies the exhibits of the School of Agriculture and Experiment Station to many county fairs. All attending these fairs will have an opportunity to inspect the library and to make a selection to add to their supply of agricultural and household economy literature.
