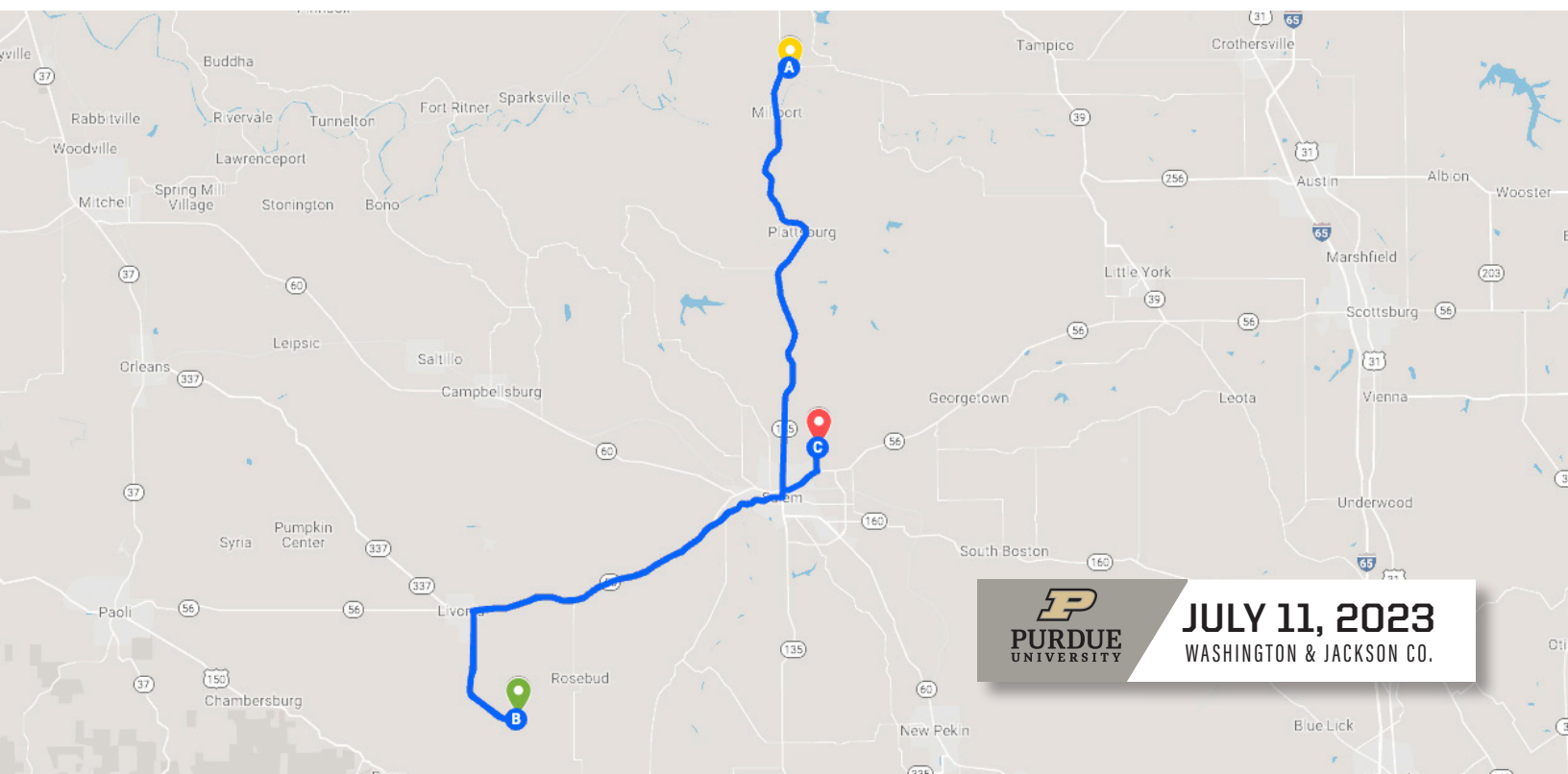
ROWLAND FARMS | 1:00 P.M.
