EARL W. KEHRBERG (1918-2015)

Professor Earl W. Kehrberg joined the Purdue Agricultural Economics staff in July, 1953 and retired in June, 1984. He taught courses and counseled students and faculty in the areas of production economics, statistics, and research methodology. He is remembered by his colleagues as a scholar's scholar. His research was concentrated in the area of production economics. He became assistant head for research in June, 1974, a position he held until February, 1983. B.S.
