"Applying knowledge to address challenges facing the farm animal industry: Feeding behavior, personality and positive states"

Animal care practices on-farm require on-going adjustment as stakeholders increasingly want assurances that animals have a good life, while also improving animal performance. In this talk, I discuss how my research themes in basic and applied ethology can improve animal welfare, performance, and management; topics will include feeding behavior, animal personality, natural behavior and assessment of positive states. Finally, I explore how this knowledge can help address current sustainability challenges that face the farm animal industry, and propose a look ahead to challenges on the horizon.
