Teams Collegiate teams will be comprised of five individuals with all scores counting. Youth teams can be comprised of up to four individuals with the best three scores contributing to the team total. Additional individuals may compete. There is no limit for teams or individuals.

Location Classes will be placed at the Purdue Animal Sciences Research & Education Center Machine Shed. Students will then be bussed to Creighton Hall of Animal Sciences for reasons.

Divisions Youth (FFA or 4H), Junior College Freshmen, Junior College Sophomores, Senior College

Contest format 12 classes of cattle, sheep and goats. Senior college and junior college sophomores will give 6 sets of reasons. Junior college freshmen and youth will give 4 sets. Lunch will be served prior to reasons.

Awards Critiques and a short awards ceremony will follow completion of reasons. Both individual and team awards will be presented.

- Dress* Casual dress (jeans and button-down shirt for all divisions).
Placing classes will take place in a non-heated machine shed.
Reasons will take place inside a heated facility.
- Materials* We will be using JudgingCard and scantrons. Contestants will use clipboards, scantron sheet, #2 pencil. Bring #2 pencils and clip boards.
