Cooler temperatures and lower humidity in recent weeks have been favorable for bull performance as noted by the increase in performance (0.7 lbs on average) since the mid-test weight. All bulls were scanned and had hip height measurements taken on August 16th. As for health since the mid-test weight, a trio of bulls have had mild lameness do to hoof cracks or foot rot. All bulls have received therapy and have improved or visually appear to be recovered.

September will be a busy month with bulls coming off-test. Please review the calendar on the reverse side of this page. Additional help on September 22 or on September 23 (weather permitting) would be much appreciated, especially on video day. Please feel free to contact me directly to say "I would like to help on this date." Assistance with the sale will be needed with sorting bulls at the test station, transporting bulls to the Springville Feeder Auction Market, penning bulls and working in back during the sale. If you would like to help please, contact me so that I can start a list!

Please make sure all of your weaning and yearling data is submitted to your respective breed associations to prevent delays in data becoming available to IBEP.

IBEP will send out "SAVE THE DATE" post cards within the next couple of weeks for the 90th IBEP Bull Sale on October 15, 2022. The post card will have the option to request a Sale catalog.
