Weights recorded yesterday marked the halfway point for the 2024 Summer Test. As planned, performance increased during the last 36 days with the necessary diet adjustments mentioned in the 28-day report. As a group, bulls averaged 3.33 lbs/day (3.77 lbs/day for Senior Division and 3.29 lbs/day for Junior Division) with a range of 5.0 to 1.6 lbs/day. Seventy-three percent of bulls on test averaged better than 3.0 lbs/day during the last 36 days. Bulls with performance below 2.5 lbs per day were evaluated by Dr. Ellen Burcham. All had normal rectal temperatures with normal lung sounds. Outside of weights, all bulls received a second and final dose of Multimin 90.

Three of the four bulls that had developed an abscess in the region of their neck have healed up nicely. One of these four bulls went home shortly after the last weight of reasons unrelated to the abscess. Following the abscess being lanced, those respectable bulls were brought up daily for one week and the location was rinsed with roughly a half liter of a water and betadine solution, followed by a mild amount of Catron® applied. After a week, cleanings were spaced out to every other day until the area had closed off entirely.

As for additional observations, there are eleven bulls that would score between a two and three on the hair shedding scoring rubric. As far as how this is influencing their performance is unknown. Five of the eleven were in the mid to upper 3's for ADG during this last 36 days with the other six being in the mid to upper 2's for ADG.

Data will be sent to Angus Media within a week to 10 days to begin developing the digital catalog. Our next scheduled weigh day is Tuesday August 13th followed by all bulls being scanned for carcass traits on Thursday August 15th. Additional help on Thursday August 15th would be greatly appreciated and a great opportunity to evaluate bulls before the final stretch of the test.

On September 10th Feldun will be hosting a *Forage Sorghum Field Day* (SAVE THE DATE Attached). From 5:00 pm until 6:00 pm, attendees will be able to tour the test station and bulls prior to off-test. This event would be a good opportunity to network with potential buyers and others interested in learning about your operation.
