

# **\*\*IMPORTANT\*\***

Bulls **MUST** be vaccinated and boosted prior to delivery to IBEP.  
The following vaccination schedule complies with IBEP rules  
and maximizes timing for optimal immunity:

**Initial vaccination:** 2/23/2024 through 3/19/2024

**Booster:** No later than April 2, 2024

**Intranasal if given:** 4/13/2024 through 4/19/2024

**Delivery day:** Tuesday, April 23, 2024

If your herd health plan has vaccination dates outside of dates listed above,  
**CONTACT** Drs. Funnell, Rusch or Burcham for consultation.

## **Modified Live Viral Vaccinations**

All bulls **MUST** be vaccinated with  
a Modified Live viral vaccine.  
Acceptable products include:  
Bovi-Shield Gold 5, Vista 5,  
Pyramid 5, and Titanium 5.

If you intend to use a vaccine not  
listed above as an acceptable  
product, please contact one of our  
veterinarians listed below.

## ***Intranasal Vaccination***

We **recommend** bulls receive BOVILIS  
NASALGEN® 3-PMH (Merck Animal Health)  
4 to 10 days prior to delivery. If not  
administered prior to delivery, bulls will be  
administered NASALGEN® 3-PMH on  
delivery day.

## ***Johne's required on ALL DAMS!***

Johne's samples need to be processed at an  
accredited American Association of  
Veterinary Laboratory Diagnosticians  
(AAVLD) laboratory.
