

IMPORTANT – Vaccination Information

Bulls **MUST** be vaccinated and boosted prior to delivery to IBEP.
The following vaccination schedule complies with IBEP rules and maximizes timing for optimal immunity:

Initial Vaccination: 8/23/2024 to 9/17/2024

Booster Vaccination: No later than October 1, 2024

Intranasal (optional): 10/12/2024 to 10/18/2024

Modified Live Viral Vaccinations

All bulls **MUST** be vaccinated with a Modified Live viral vaccine. Acceptable products include: Bovi-Shield Gold 5, Vista 5, Pyramid 5, and Titanium 5.

Intranasal Vaccination

We **recommend** bulls receive BOVILIS NASALGEN® 3-PMH (Merck Animal Health) 4 to 10 days prior to delivery. If not administered prior to delivery, bulls will be administered NASALGEN® 3-PMH on delivery day.

Current Johne's test on gestating and or foster dam. See Rules, page 4, number 3. Johne's samples need to be processed at an accredited American Association of Veterinary Laboratory Diagnosticians (AAVLD) laboratory.
