IMPORTANT Definitions!!! (Please Read)

Farm Market Retailer: Any producer who sells eggs directly to the consumer, which they produced, at a common facility that meets the definition of a farm market in (IC 16-42-11-1.1 (3))

Retail/On-Line sales: Any person who sells eggs for human consumption and **NOT** for resale is required to have a retail permit. Utilizing a virtual retail marketing platform to sell eggs that are delivered or shipped to the end consumer is considered a retail sale and requires a retail permit (See Retail Application)

Wholesaler: Any person selling eggs for human consumption to retailers, hotels, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, schools or state or federal institutions.
