Galerucella life cycle in a wetland habitat

adults go into dormant state (diapause) in wetland

new adults emerge, feed heavily on loosestrife in wetland

mature larvae move to soil, pupate

eggs hatch, larvae feed on loosestrife until mature

adults feed, mate, lay eggs, die

adults emerge from dormancy

adults in dormant state (diapause) in wetland
