

Responding to and Collecting Information at the Crash Site

Right after a crash, the scene is chaotic.

This card will help drivers and supervisors know first steps to take after every crash. Keep a copy in your vehicle or office in case of an emergency.

Drivers . . .

- Call 911**
- Notify Supervisor and Request Their Presence**
- Render Aid**
- Exchange Insurance Information Only**
- Do Not Discuss Incident Except with Police**
- Write or Record What You Remember Soon**

Supervisors . . .

- Test Your Driver for Alcohol and Drugs**
- Make Sure Law Enforcement Files a Report**
- Take Lots of Photos**
- Ensure Drivers Write or Record What They Remember Soon**
- Notify Your Insurance Carrier As Soon As Possible**
