Private Applicator (Farmer) Restricted Use Pesticide Application Record Requirements

- 1. Address, geographic coordinates, or general location description of site of application.
- 2. Name and license number of the certified applicator.
- 3. Date of application (month, day, year).
- 4. Start and stop times of the application.
- 5. Description of plant, crop or site treated.
- 6. Principal pests to be controlled.
- 7. Specific acreage, area, parts of a property or number of plants or animals treated, or other appropriate description.
- 8. Brand name of pesticide product applied.
- 9. EPA registration number of the pesticide product applied.
- 10. Amount of pesticide product used, expressed as either total quantity or volume of:
 - A) Packaged product; or
 - B) Diluted mixture and active ingredient concentration (percentage).

Records must be kept for 2 years. Records can be kept electronically; no specific form is required.

*Restricted Use Pesticides can ONLY be applied by a certified private applicator.
