Eligibility: Please check to confirm eligibility requirements

- Cooperative effort of at least one field staff educator and at least one campus staff specialist (includes campus AP staff).
- Educator(s) and specialist(s) may be from any discipline area.
- At least one individual of the team must be a current member of IEEA, PUCESA, and/or Epsilon Sigma Phi.
- A team composed of the same individuals may win only once.

Award: Award recipients receive individually framed certificates. A plaque listing the winners for each year will be on display in AGAD at Purdue University. A committee representing IEEA, PUCESA, and or Epsilon Sigma Phi will select award recipients. The PUCESA Awards Chair will present the award during the annual Purdue Cooperative Extension Awards Banquet.

Nominations: Submit this nomination form AND one double-spaced letter of support identifying: 1) the program and its impact on families, and 2) steps required to replicate the program. No additional support materials will be accepted.
