Eligibility: Please select one award category.

PUCESA membership required for Early Career, Mid-Career, and Career Award

- Early Career Award: CES Specialist/Administrator – up to 10 years of service
- Mid-Career Award: CES Specialist/Administrator - 11-20 years of service
- Career Award: CES Specialist/Administrator - over 20 years of service

Award: Award recipients receive a plaque.

Nominations: Submit (1) a completed PUCESA Award Nomination Form, (2) a description of accomplishments **not to exceed two pages**, and (3) at least two letters of support. Applications that do not meet the above criteria will not be accepted.

Accomplishments: There are many attributes that make a candidate worthy of a PUCESA award. Please provide a brief description of each of the following that apply: 1) extension leadership, 2) demonstrated excellence and innovation to program content and delivery, 3) research which benefits extension clientele through practical application, and 4) demonstrated collaboration with county educators, agencies, and/or leaders.
