2025 Award Application

Annually, the Purdue Women in Agriculture (WIA) Team recognizes individuals who are leaders and innovators contributing to the success of Indiana agriculture and, in doing so, have facilitated the advancement of women in agriculture. The Emerging Leader in Agriculture Award recognizes our high school and college undergrad students that are making an impact on agriculture. Currently, the Purdue WIA Team is accepting applications for the 2025 Purdue Women in Agriculture Awards.

We encourage all those who are making impact for agriculture to apply. Those that meet the criteria may nominate themselves, or be nominated by someone else.

Winners will be recognized at the Indiana State Fair during the Celebration of Ag ceremony.

Criteria for Eligibility

1. Reside in Indiana.
2. Must be actively involved in Agriculture or is/are planning to pursue an agriculture career
3. The nominee must be in high school and/or undergraduate college student
4. The nominee has the option to attend the awards ceremony and activities related to the award given at the Indiana State Fair (date TBD). After the initial review by the Women in Ag Team, the award finalists will be contacted to see availability for their attendance at the awards ceremony. However, being during school hours we understand this may not be possible.
5. Nominee has done a project that has made a difference and contribution to the agriculture community that is a significant impact

Guidelines for Submission

1. The application will be considered for 2 consecutive years, as long as they still fall into the age requirements. If the nominee is not chosen in those 2 years, the application may be resubmitted for consideration.
2. One or two letters of support should be submitted with the application.
