

Aquaculture technician at the Aquaculture Research Lab, ASREC, Purdue University

Job description: Assist with care and maintenance of fish stocks and lab functions at the lab located at ASREC, approximately 10 miles from campus. Two main projects include rearing of walleye and largemouth bass fingerlings. Some of the activities would include fish feeding, water quality monitoring, harvesting and selling fish, cleaning and organizing the lab and equipment. Lots of hands-on experience for someone interested in aquaculture. Weekend work required.

Time Frame: Beginning of spring semester, 2026 (approximately 10 hours/week). Position can continue through the summer (approximately 20 hours per week) if interested. Looking for potentially a 1-2 year position.
