Complete as a team an assortment of hands-on conservation projects for a 19 week experience. The first 5 weeks (July) of the program involves leading a team of 10 high school youth in conservation work and environmental education. In the second part of the program (Aug.-Oct.), you will work among 5 young adults with 2 crew leaders in a deeper experience to gain advanced ecological restoration skills, certifications, and practice.

Qualifications

- Experience/being open to working outdoors
- Ability to perform manual, physical labor
- Must be minimum of 18-22 years of age
- Knowledge of local ecology is a big plus
