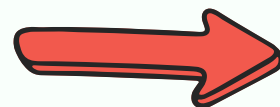

## Education and Qualification Requirements:

- Must have at least a high school diploma
- Qualified candidates will have a strong base of knowledge in nature, biology and the outdoor world.
- Knowledge of modern technology used in program presentation.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must possess a valid driver's license and the demonstration of a safe driving record.

## Desired Skills:

- Experience with environmental education and/or interpretation
- Knowledge of the Hendricks County area
- Knowledge of Indiana wildlife, plant life, and ecosystems

## Working Conditions and Physical Demands:

- This position requires the ability to perform duties indoor and outdoor, during all seasons. There will be tasks that require the ability to walk/stand for long periods of time, walking on uneven terrain, and varying elevations. This position also requires the ability to speak and present programs clearly and effectively. Must be able to lift/carry objects weighing up to 25 lbs.
- The position is 28 hours/week, with four 7-hour/day shifts. The position runs from May-August, but can be adjusted as needed. June and July are required working months.
- Scheduling for the position includes some evenings and weekends.
