

TWO PAID OPPORTUNITIES FOR AQUACULTURE TRAINING AT UWSP NADF

The facility is offering two paid opportunities: a 3-month summer internship to either a high school student or undergraduate student as well as a six-month apprenticeship for an individual not currently enrolled in school. Both opportunities would be stationed at UWSP NADF (University of Wisconsin Stevens Point, Northern Aquaculture Demonstration Facility) in Bayfield, Wisconsin.

SUMMER INTERNSHIP - 3 MONTH FULL TIME

- Eligibility: Currently enrolled as a junior or senior in high school or undergraduate at any college/university during summer 2025 with interest in aquaculture, fisheries, natural resources or related fields.
- Pay: ~\$16/hr. full time from approx. June - August, negotiable start/end dates.
- Gain experience with all aquaculture systems and species at the facility including Atlantic salmon, walleye and lake trout, recirculating systems, ponds, flow-through systems.
- Assist in research projects including data collection and organization.
- Assist in public outreach at the facility including tours and public events.
