Wildlife Rehabilitation Internships 2025 – Full Time & Part Time Positions Available

Wildcat Creek Wildlife Center is a wildlife rehabilitation and hospital facility located in Indiana. Annually we admit 2000 wildlife patients of all native and migratory species. We rehabilitate mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and all avian species.

Interns work hands-on with over 100 different species. New skill sets learned will include different feeding techniques, preparation of species specific formulas and weaning diets, enrichment protocols and animal restraint techniques. Interns also have the opportunity to read radiographs, observe surgeries and participate in postoperative care of wildlife patients under the supervision of our medical staff.

We are looking for interns that can enthusiastically work 60 to 70 hours a week. The work week consists of five 12 to 14 hour days and two non-consecutive days off per week. Minimum time commitment is 10 weeks. This is an unpaid internship but does include housing at the center for full-time interns. Part-time positions are also available and consist of three 10 hour days per week. Part-time positions do not include housing. Schedules are extremely flexible as we operate seven days a week, 14 hours a day. In most cases, we can schedule around classes and or jobs.

Interns work in a fast-paced, high stress, multitasking environment. Come have fun with us this summer! We are hoping to have our summer internships filled by mid March so apply today!
