

## Indiana Poultry Exemptions

<b>Distribution:</b>	Distribution direct to household consumers Includes sales at the farm, farmers markets, roadside stands and through delivery.		Distribution to retail Stores, hotels, restaurants and institutions.

<b>Market</b>	Poultry products may not move in interstate commerce. <b>Labels</b>	Poultry products must be labeled according to BOAH rules. Statement "Exempt PL 90-492"	Poultry products must be labeled according to BOAH rules. <b>Facility</b>	Must be clean and sanitary as to not cause adulteration of product. No approval required.
