About the Position

The Superintendent will be responsible for the golf course grounds, turf-management program, equipment, seasonal maintenance, and coordination of the grounds crew.

Key Responsibilities

- Manage the daily maintenance and presentation of the golf course, including greens, tees, fairways, roughs, bunkers, and surrounding grounds.
- Develop and implement a comprehensive turf-management and agronomic program.

 - Manage the irrigation system and coordinate repairs and seasonal start-up/shut-down procedures.
- Hire, train, schedule, and supervise seasonal and part-time grounds staff as needed.
- Maintain accurate records of chemical applications, fertilization, irrigation, equipment maintenance, and other course operations.
 - Manage the grounds maintenance budget and make recommendations regarding equipment, materials, and course improvements.

- Work closely with club leadership and communicate course conditions, maintenance needs, and upcoming projects.
- Ensure compliance with applicable local, state, and federal regulations regarding pesticide use, employee safety, and environmental practices.
- Assist with special projects and course improvements, including tree work, drainage, landscaping, bunker maintenance, and other improvements as appropriate.

Qualifications

Preferred qualifications include:

- Previous experience as part of a golf maintenance team or assistant superintendent, or in a comparable turf-management position.
- Strong knowledge of golf course turfgrass, agronomy, irrigation, pest management, and seasonal maintenance practices.
- Experience operating and maintaining golf course equipment.
- Ability to supervise, train, and motivate a grounds crew.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and make sound decisions regarding course conditions and maintenance priorities.
- Pesticide application certification or willingness to obtain the appropriate Indiana certification.
- Valid driver's license.
- Turf-management education, certification, or degree is preferred but not required for the right candidate.
