**Position Summary:** The Lead Arborist is responsible for the care, maintenance, and preservation of trees throughout the Meijer Gardens' landscape. This position oversees arboricultural operations, including tree health assessments, pruning, removals, and planting. The Lead Arborist collaborates with the horticulture team, supervises staff and volunteers, coordinates contractor activities, and ensures that all arboricultural work aligns with Meijer Gardens' mission and standards of excellence. Additionally, this position is responsible for implementing best practices in tree care, risk management, and environmental stewardship.

## **Essential Functions:**

- Perform all aspects of tree care, including planting, pruning, health assessments, pest and disease management, and removals.
