The Lead Designer collaborates with the horticulture team, supervises seasonal staff and volunteers, coordinates with external vendors, and ensures that all floral work and botanical design aligns with Meijer Gardens' mission and aesthetic standards. Additionally, this role involves research into emerging design trends, sustainability practices, and innovative display techniques to enhance visitor experience.
