

Resonance Gardens is looking for part time assistance throughout the year. The ideal candidate will be able to work 10-20 hours a week through the school year. Working hours during the summer could be up to 30 hours a week, open to discussion. This is a paid position. The position is open to a landscape architecture student of any year.

The intern would be working under the direct supervision of a licensed landscape architect. They would help with site measurements and analysis, preparing base plans, drafting final designs, and preparing presentation materials. Other office tasks may be required. Occasionally, the intern may be asked to unload a truckload of plants (up to 40 lbs each) and to set plants on site according to our design.

Resonance Gardens primarily works on residential projects, in a partnership with the homeowner or local contractors. We work out of the Matchbox, in downtown Lafayette. Our projects are typically in the Greater Lafayette area, with some exceptions within an hour drive.
