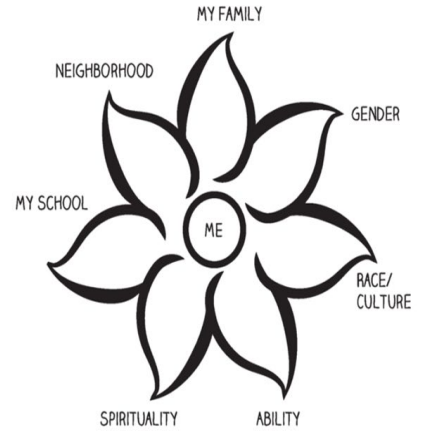


ALL ABOUT ME FLOWER

Write your name in the center of the flower. Draw or paste a picture of yourself. In each petal, write things you would like to share about yourself.



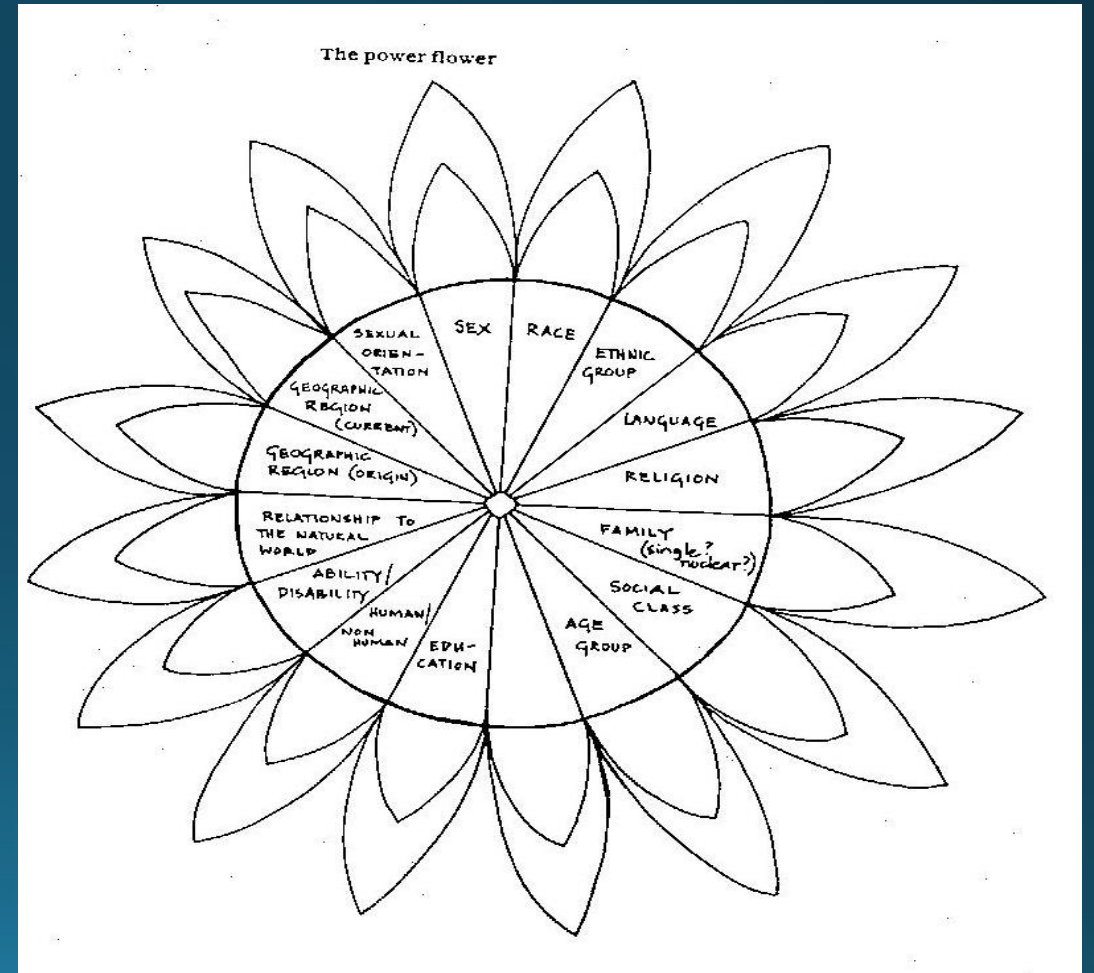
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Power Flower
