ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Study + Internship program in Florence allows you to make steady progress toward your academic degree while developing practical skills in fields such as museum studies, marketing, culinary arts, public relations, design, tourism, and more. The program incorporates a professional internship placement into your summer study program. Our strong academic focus, personalized placements dedicated to meaningful experiences that make a real impact allow you to take care of those degree requirements and give your career a boost all while gaining the international experience you've been seeking.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The placement process involves three video interviews: a screening interview with your Internship Specialist, a job placement interview with your study center placement coordinator, and a final interview with your host site supervisor. The host site retains the final decision regarding placements, so it's important that your interviews reflect your maturity, adaptability, curiosity, and commitment to both your career interests and the host organization. Upon successfully completing your study center placement coordinator interview, CEA guarantees you a placement based on the personal, professional, and cross-cultural goals reflected in your interview. All placements will be secured two weeks prior to arrival. Upon placement, you'll automatically be enrolled in your internship course. Prior to departure, you will be asked to also select your preferred courses and indicate your estimated Italian language level. After you arrive in Florence, you'll take a language placement exam to determine final placement. You will be enrolled into courses based on their availability.

WHERE YOU'LL STUDY

The CEA Florence Center offers a variety of courses that allow you to explore all that Florence has to offer, with your professors as guides. Classes are small, taught in English, and take full advantage of the city just beyond our doors. Experiential learning opportunities outside the classroom are plentiful and bring lessons to life, exposing you to new perspectives and starting you on your journey toward global citizenship.
