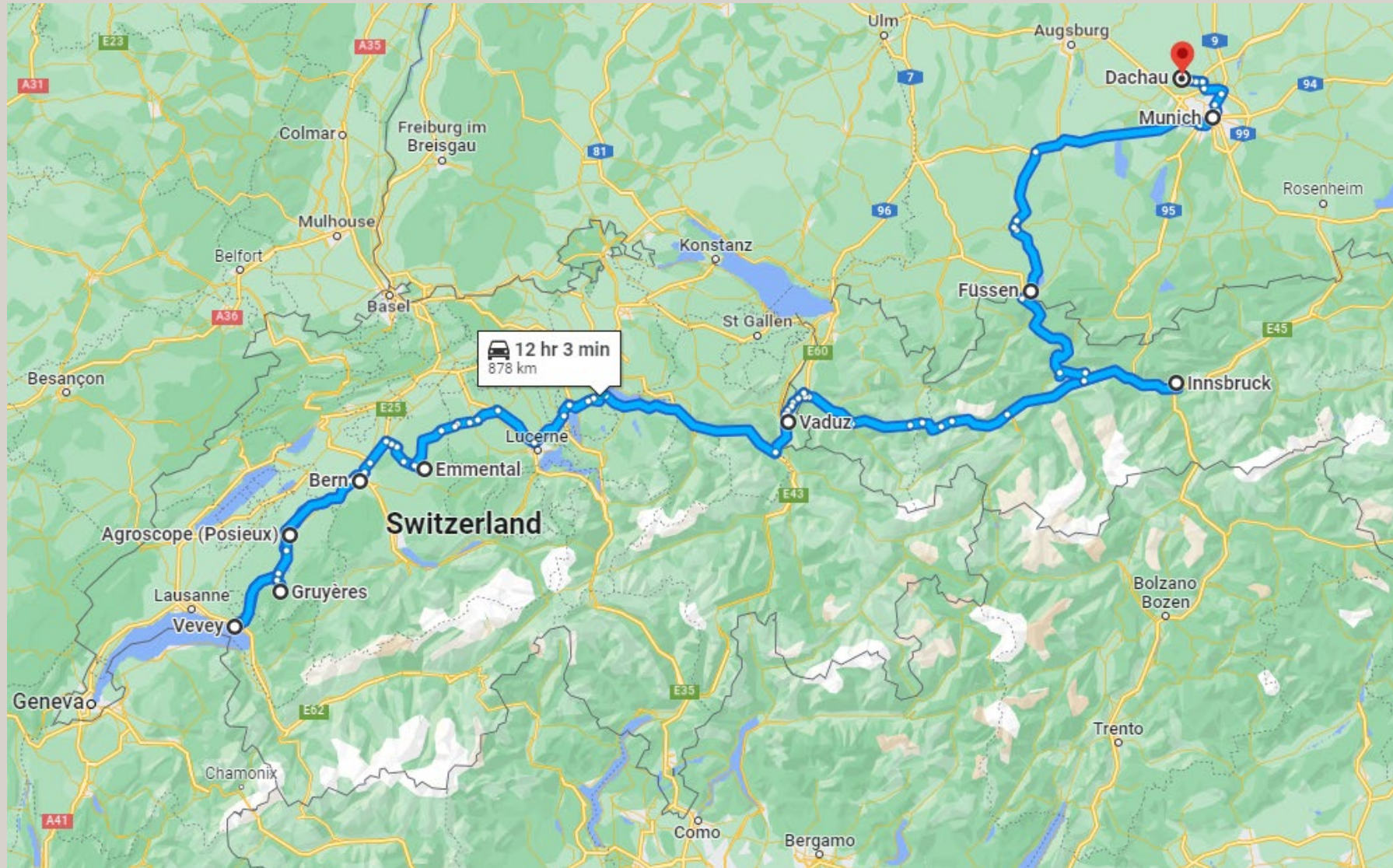

  - c. International Airfare

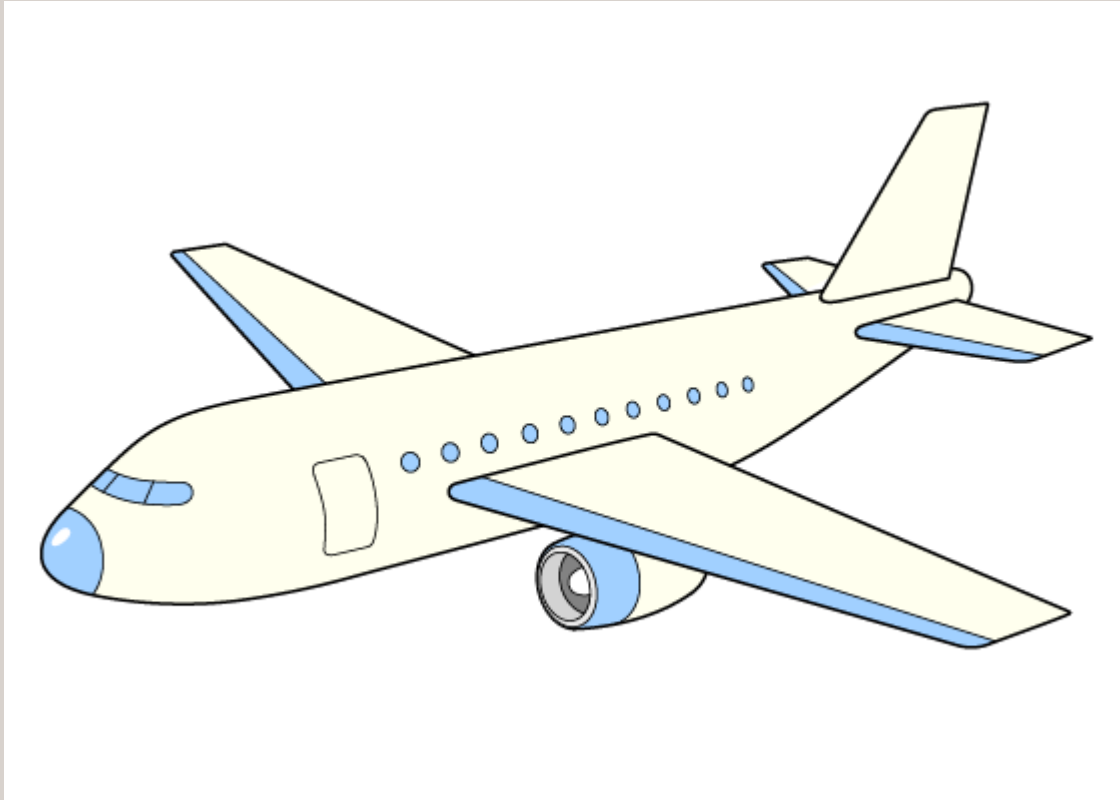
