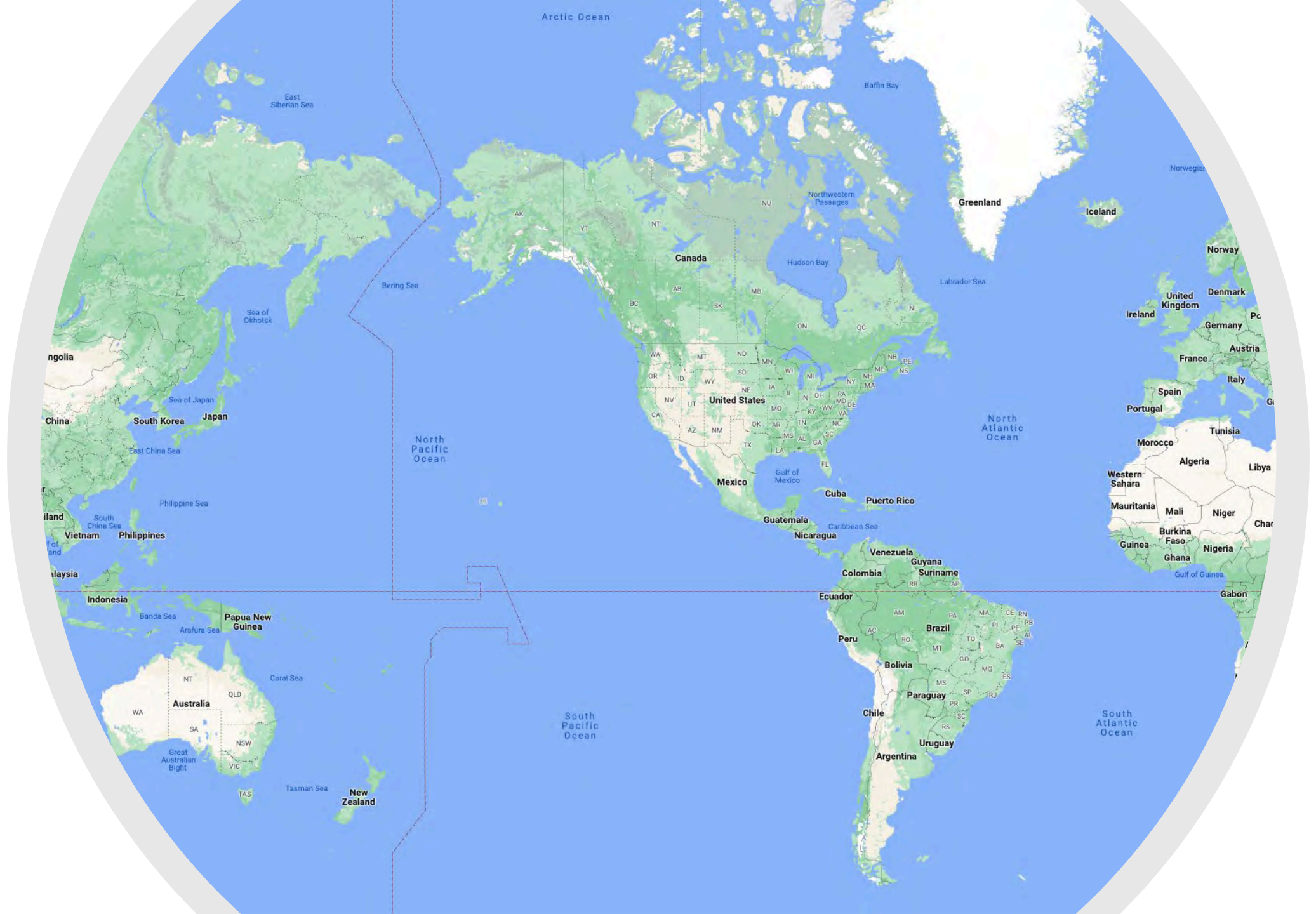

Equivalent latitudes

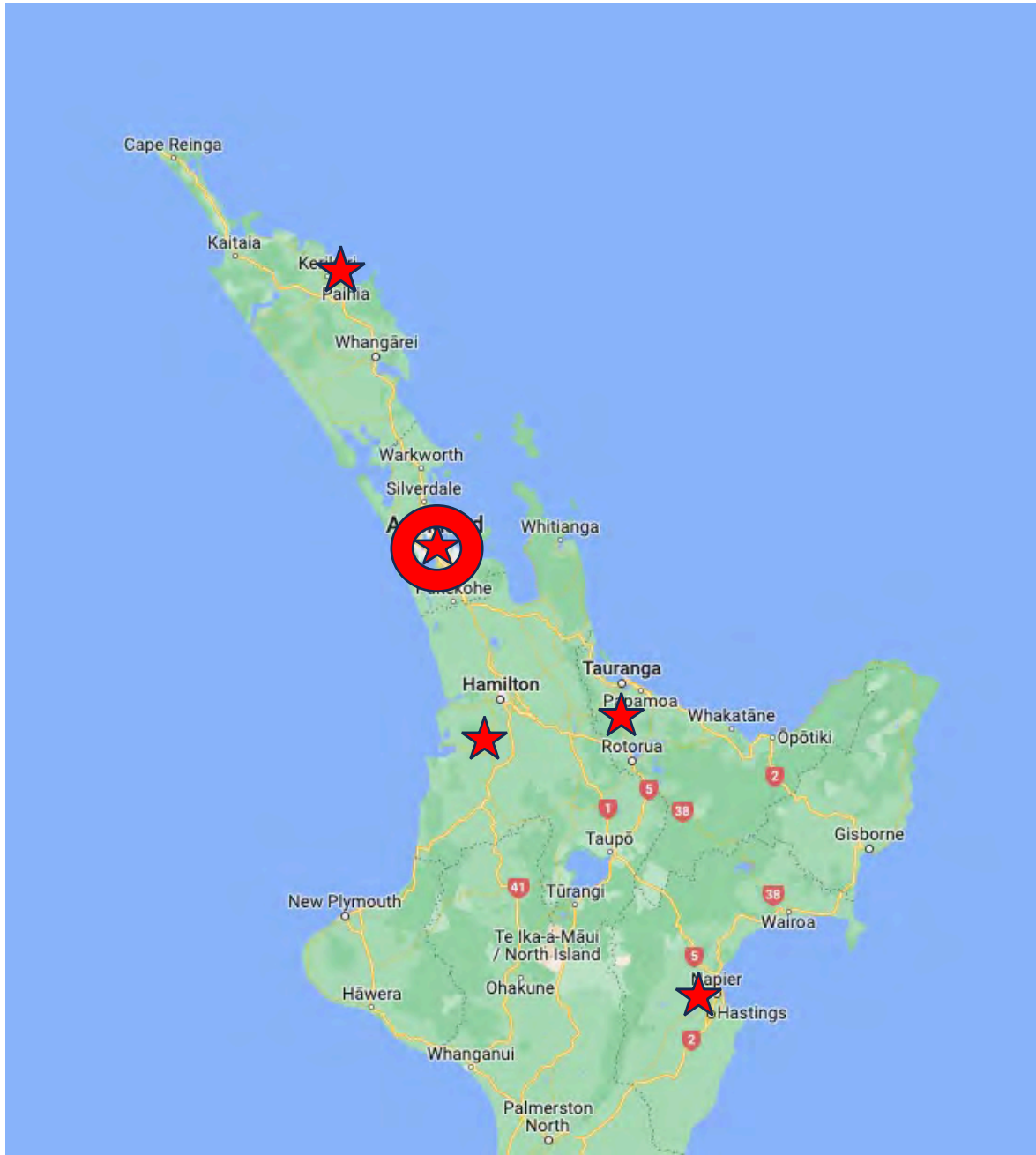


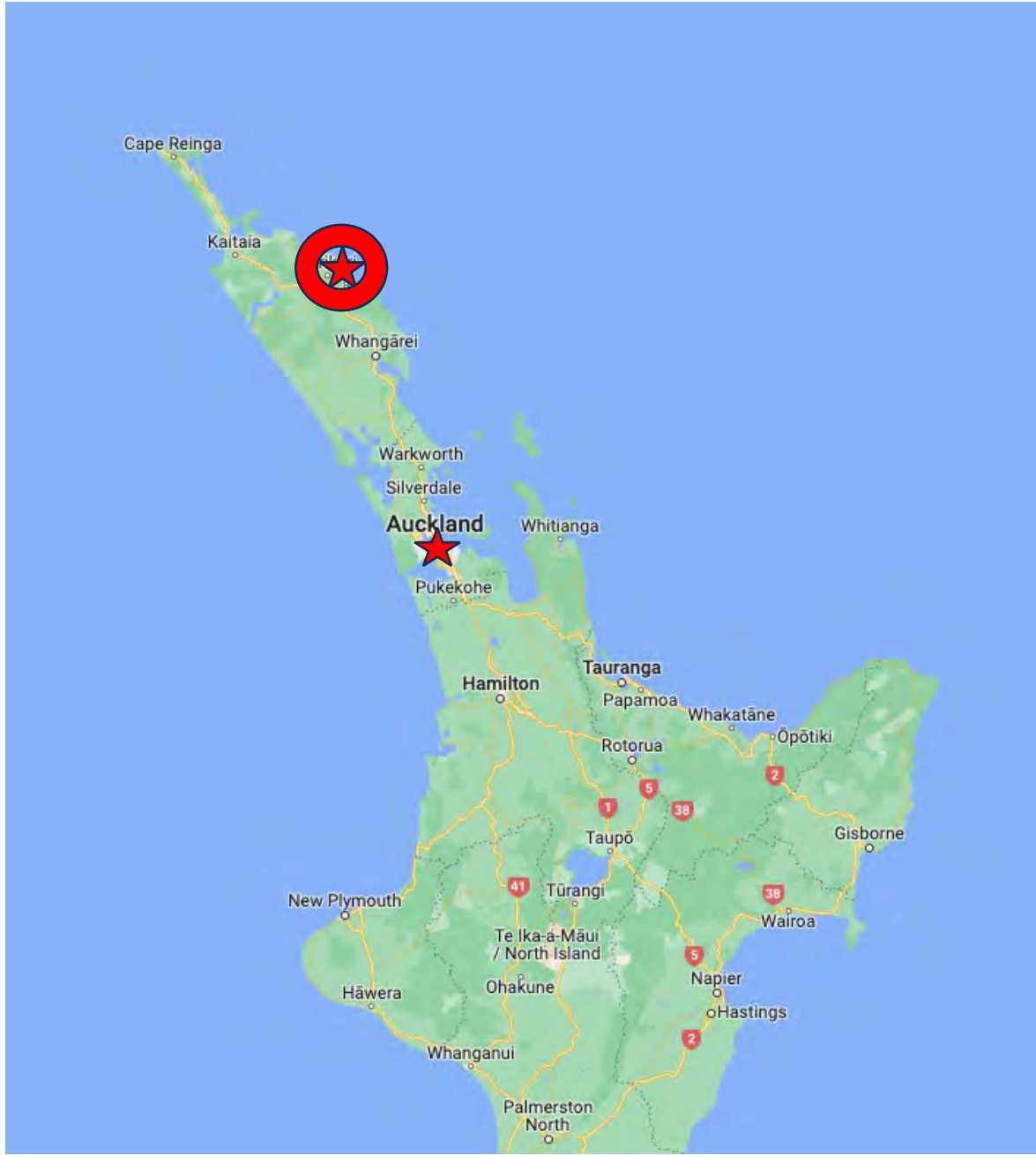
3 main islands:

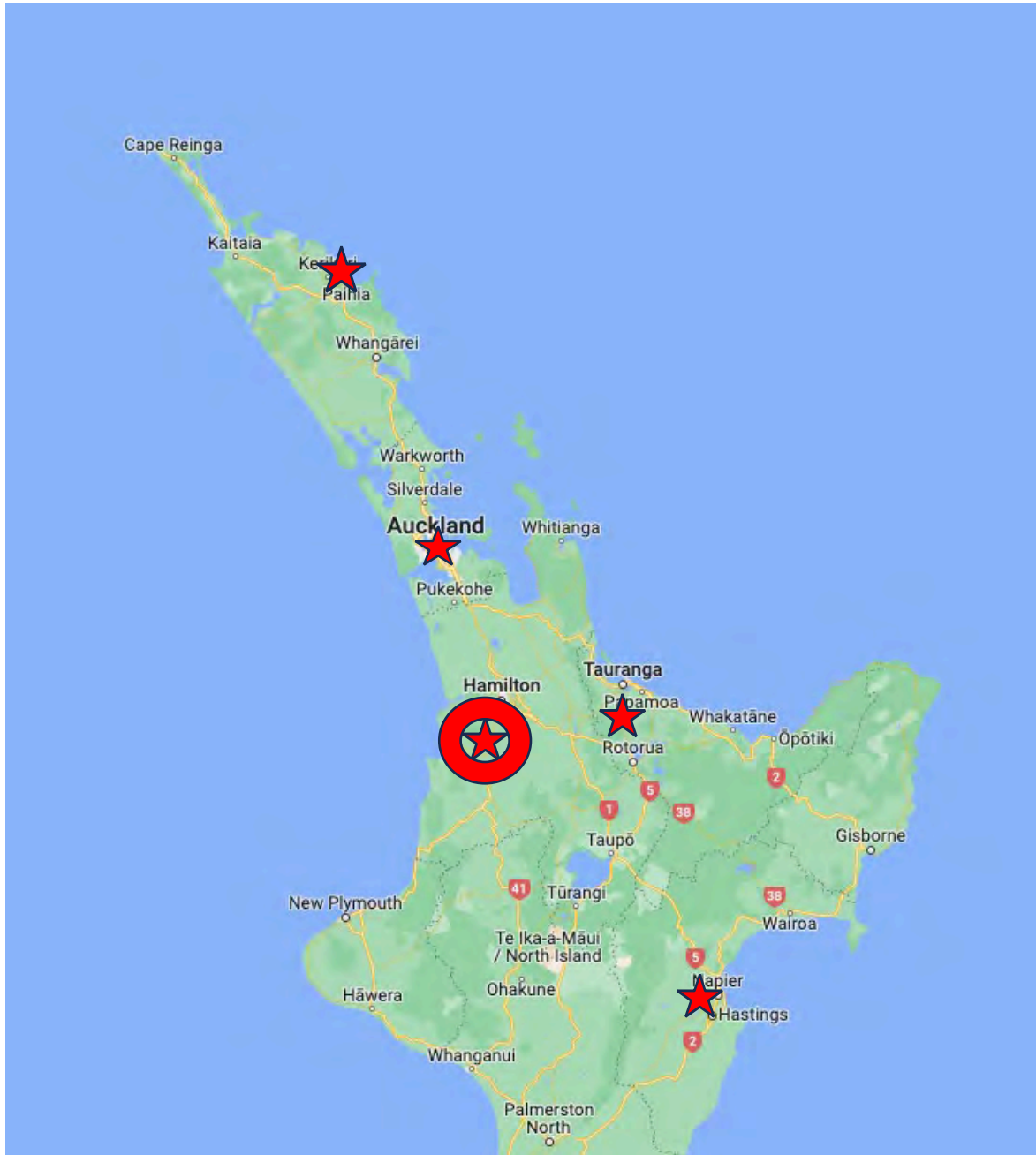
North Island

Stewart Island

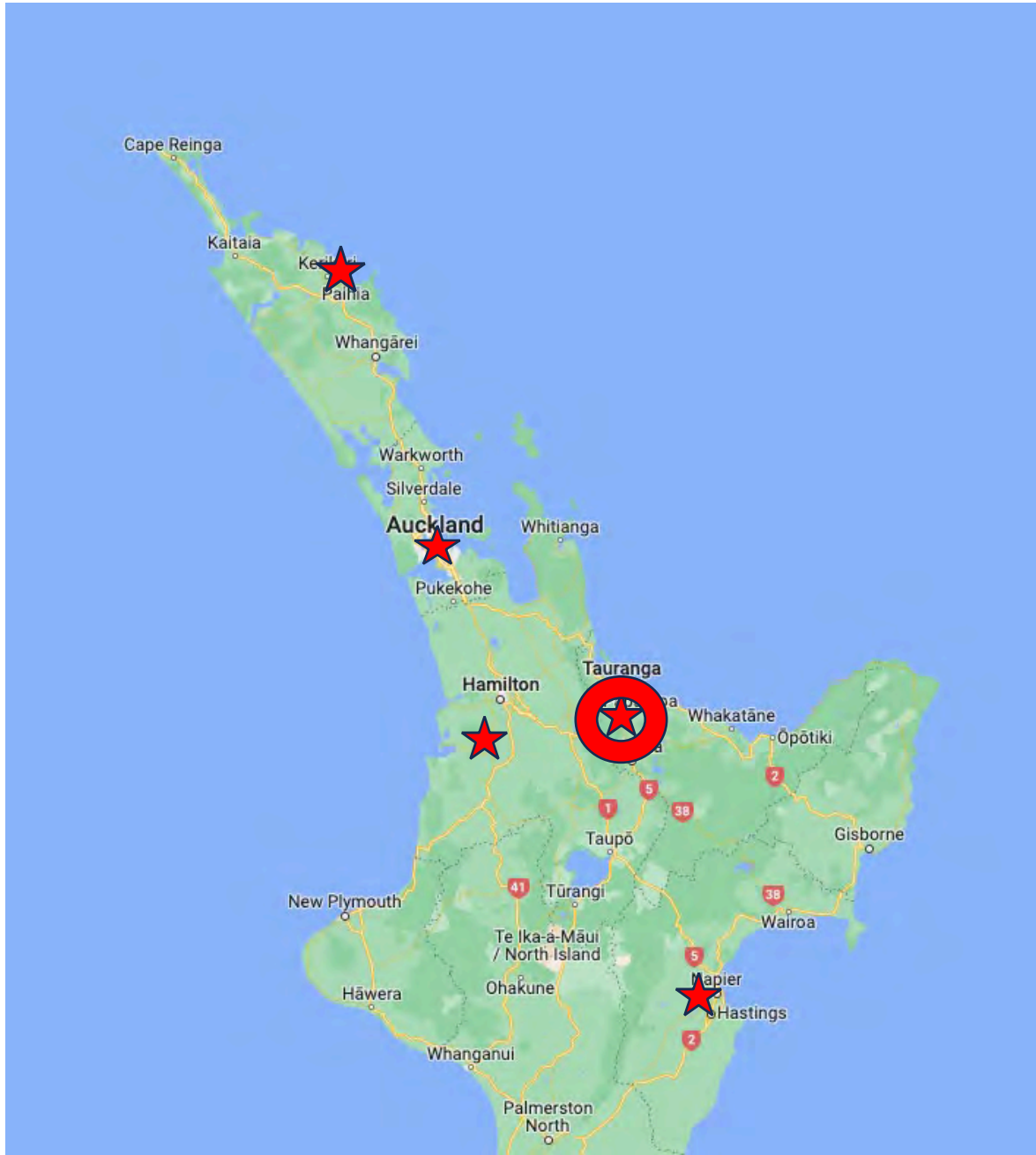
Land area = 103,000 sq. miles
(= Colorado, 3x Indiana)

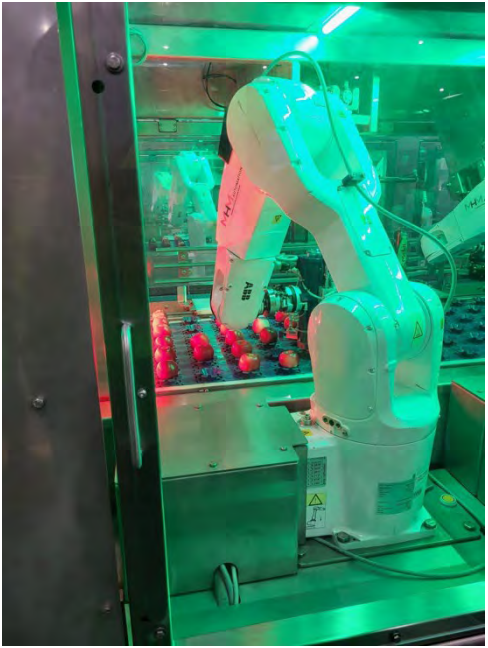
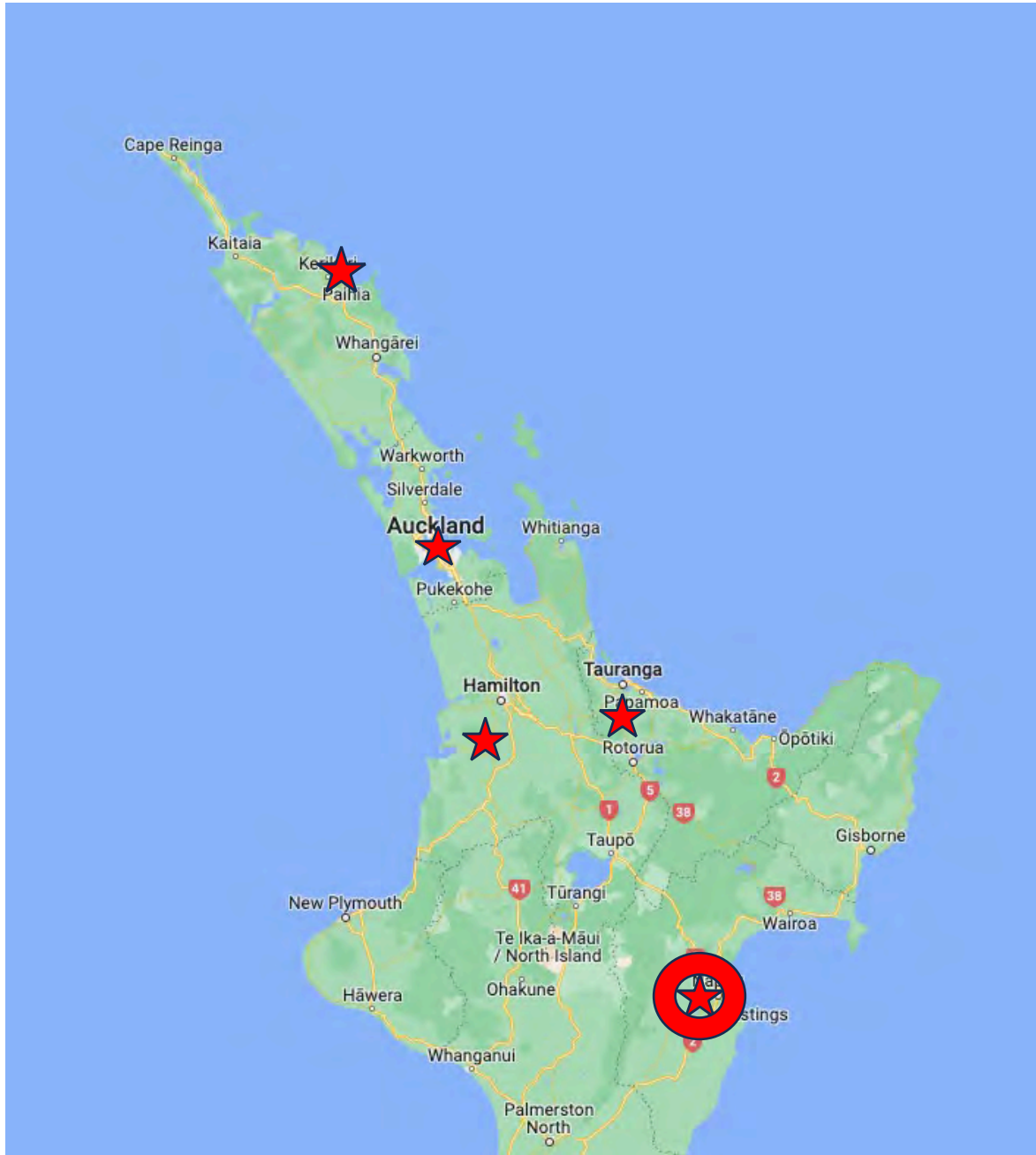


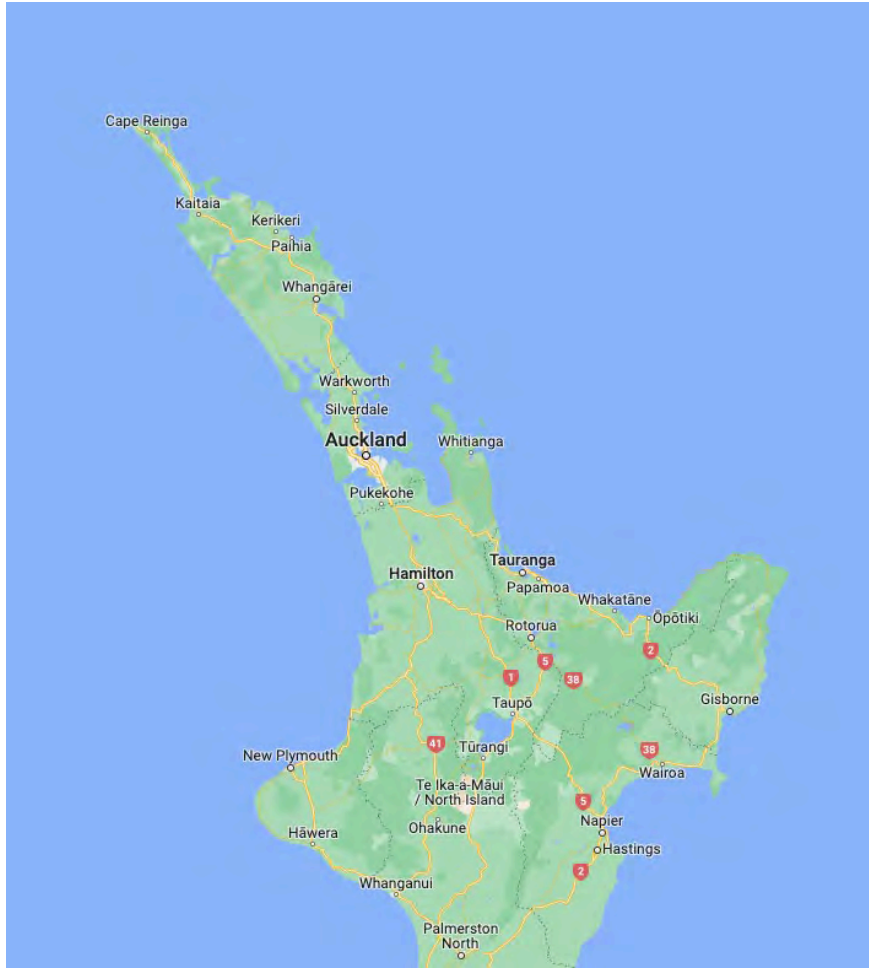




















A few details:
