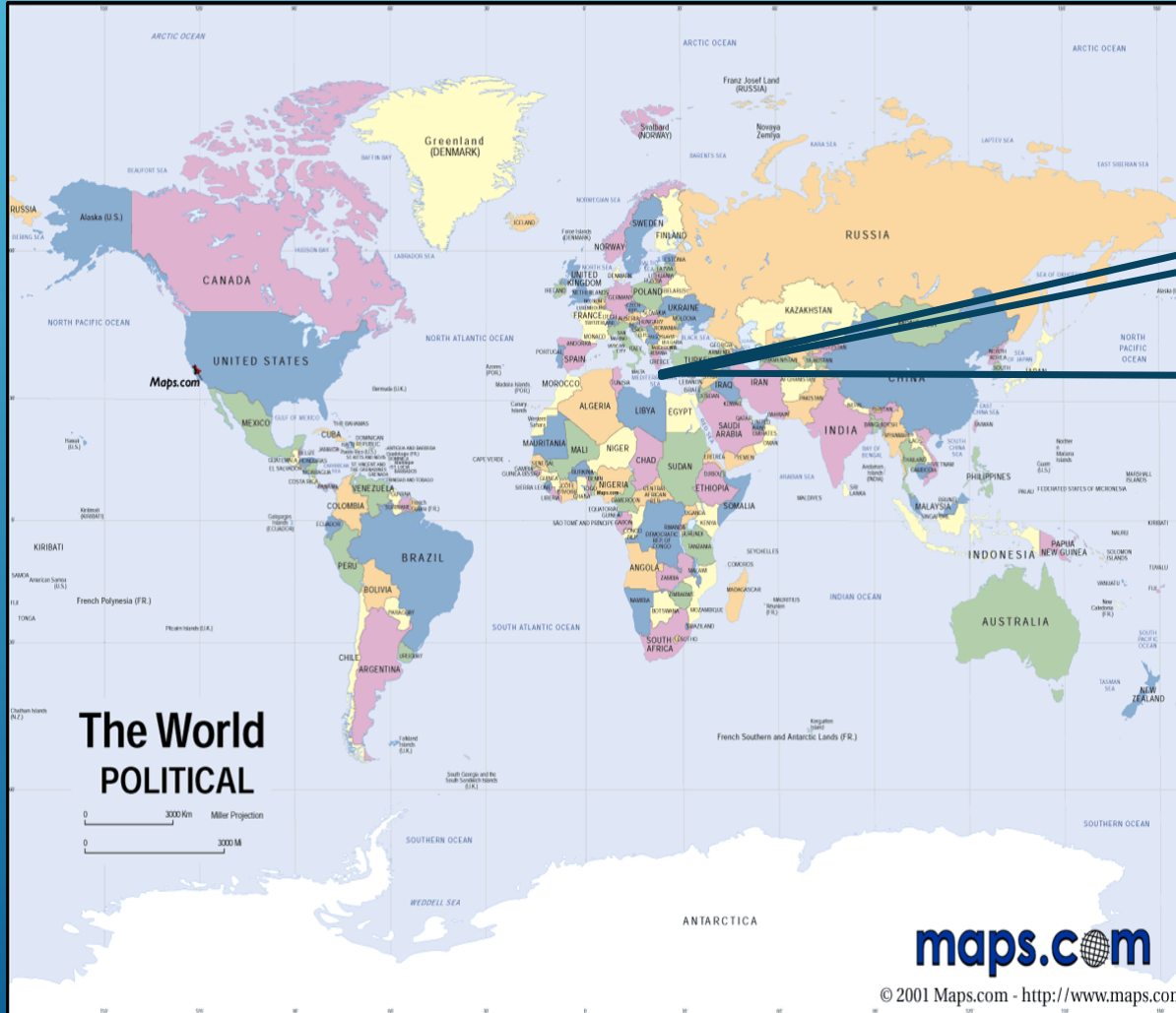


WHY GREECE?

- ▶ Opportunity to learn European production strategies compared to United States

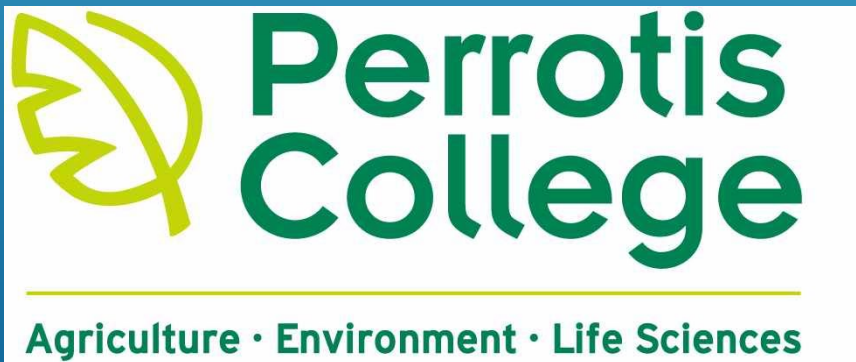


Greece Destinations

American Farm School



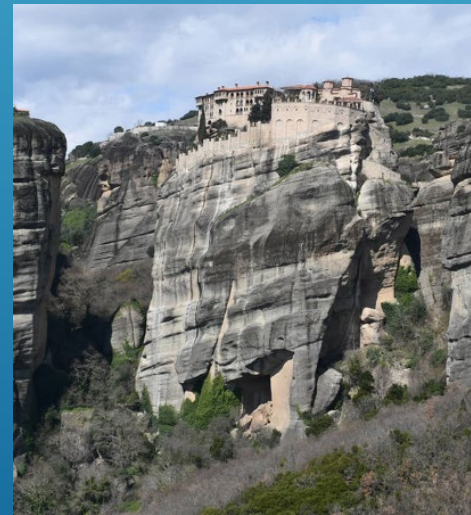

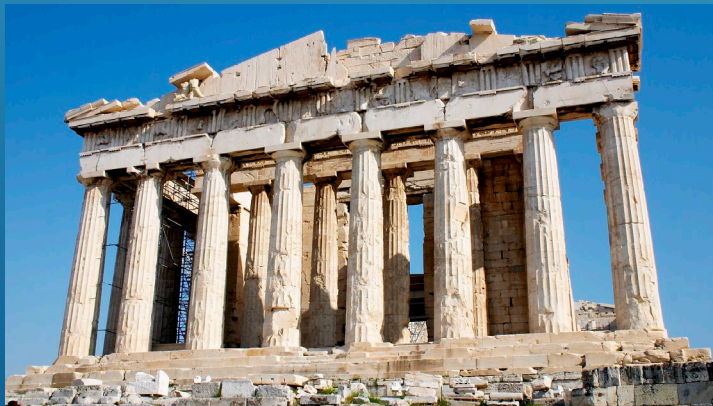
- Largest city in Greece
