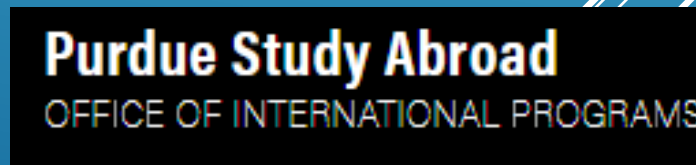

WHY GREECE?

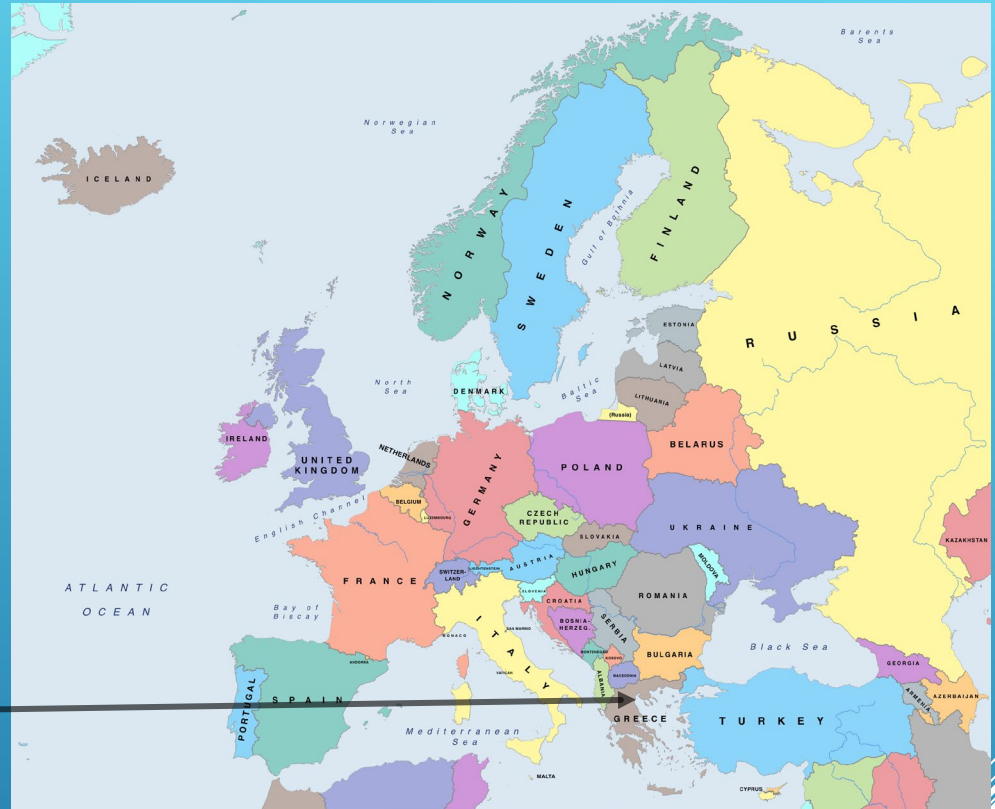
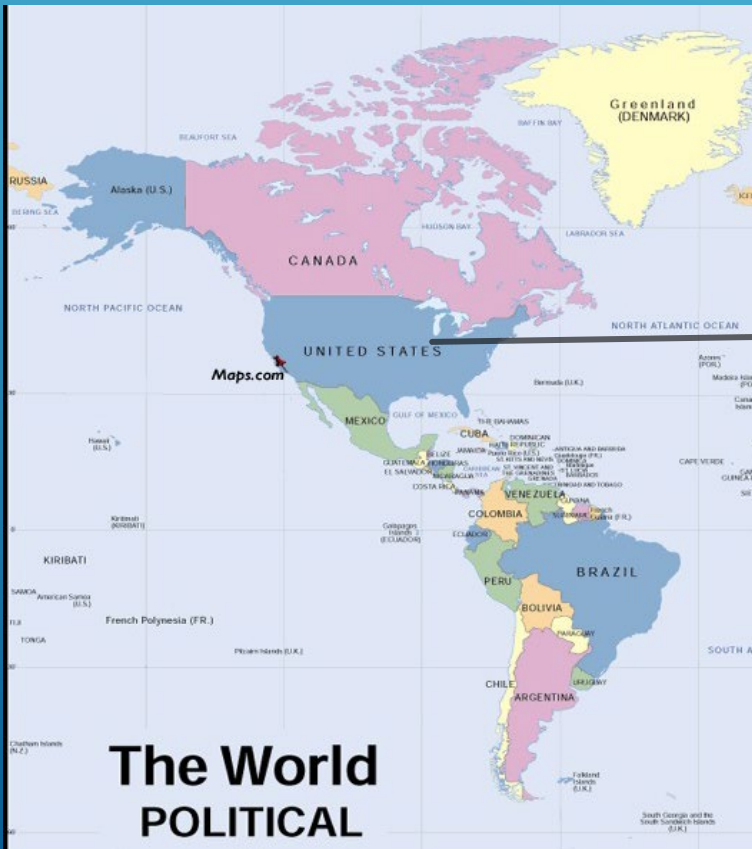
- ▶ *Variety of agricultural products: Olives, Olive Oil, Cheese, Wines, Honey, more.*

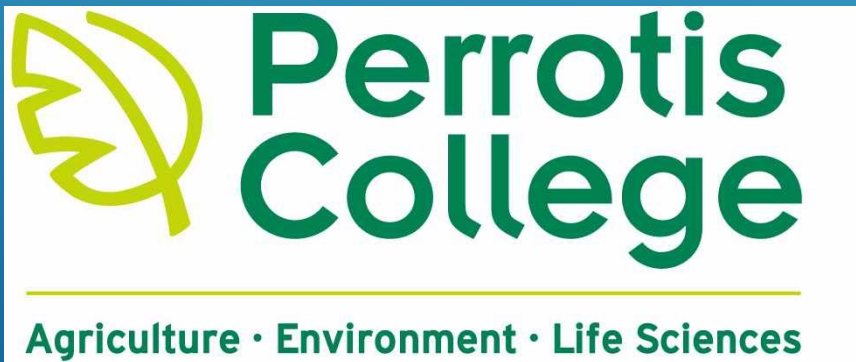

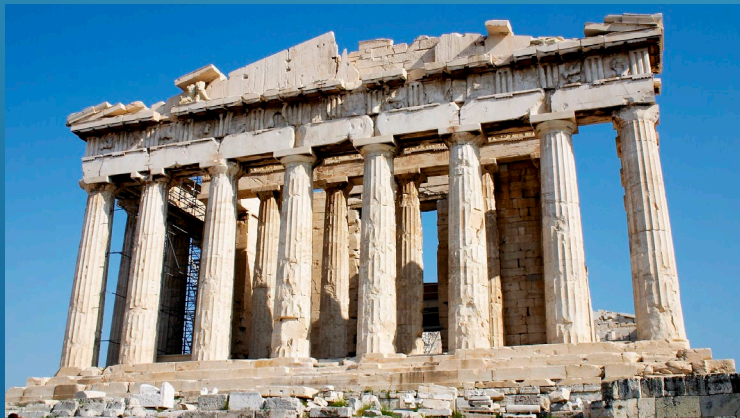

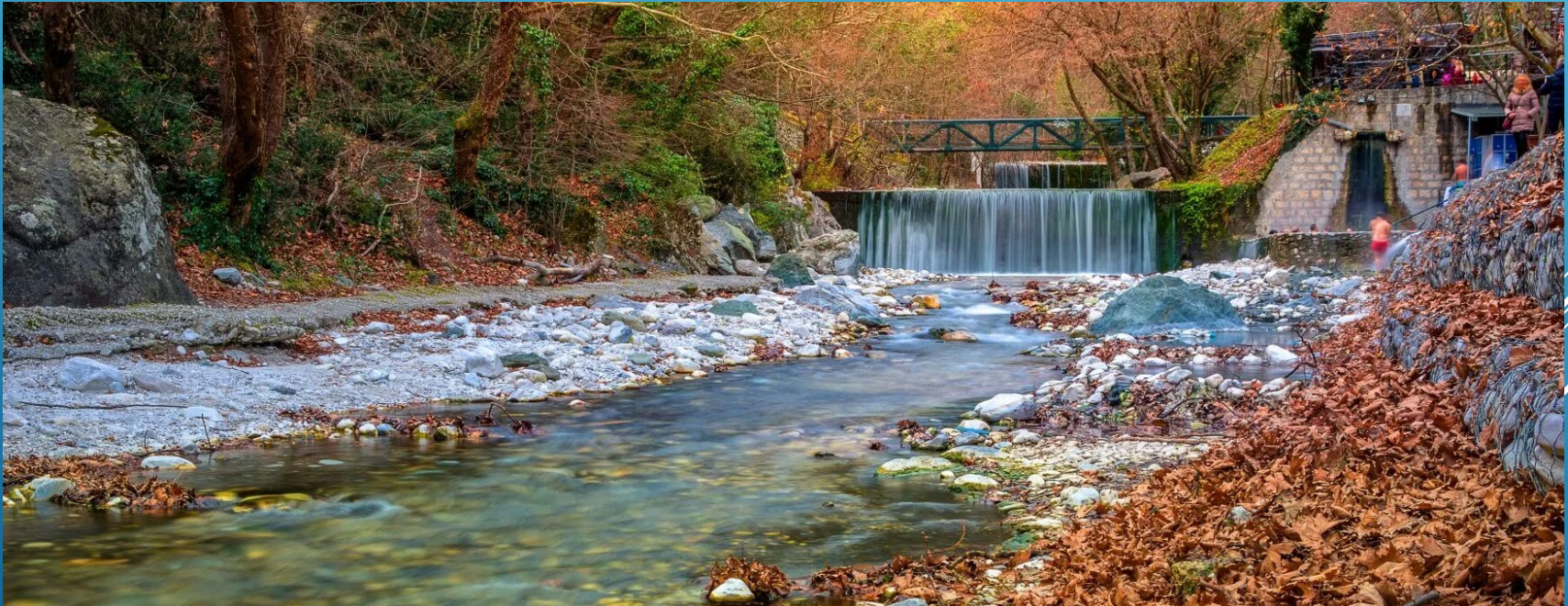
