Ambassador Role:

The Ambassadors have two main roles. One is to represent NRES as needed at various events throughout the year. Ambassadors should feel comfortable sharing their own experiences; answering questions from current students, prospective students, parents, and alumni; and generating enthusiasm for the NRES program. Events could include admissions/recruiting events, prospective student visits, alumni events, learning community activities, and set up/tear down at these events as needed.

Another role of our ambassadors is to foster a sense of community within the NRES major and promote student events, as well as mentor our first year students. Ambassadors will meet regularly to receive instruction and practice becoming comfortable speaking and answering questions.

Ambassadors will be required to attend at least 3 events per semester in addition to regular meetings. These events include: prospective student visits (Purdue's for Me, Introducing Purdue, etc.), Welcome Bash, Homecoming, Graduation awards celebration, as well as other events throughout the year.

Ambassadors will be expected to write a blog post regarding NRES experiences and activities at least once per semester.
