

PATHWAY TO PURDUE

STUDENT CONTRACT

Congratulations on being accepted to the Pathway to Purdue Agriculture Program. Being in the Ag Pathway Program is a privilege, and with privilege comes certain responsibilities. To remain in the program, the following criteria must be met and/or maintained:

- 1) Participate in community-building and academic support activities (list provided in AGR 10700).
- 2) Maintain registration in a minimum of 12 credit hours each fall/spring, which includes enrollment in at least one resident semester course at Purdue University.
Please note, successful completion of no fewer than 15 applicable credit hours per semester and 30 applicable credit hours per academic year is required to graduate on-time. Understand that recipients of Indiana state financial assistance such as the Frank O'Bannon and 21st Century Scholar awards must complete 30 credit hours per academic year in order to remain eligible for subsequent state financial aid. On an annual basis, these students must submit the Free Application for Federal Student AID (FAFSA) by the priority deadline at <https://fafsa.ed.gov> in order to be considered for subsequent state aid.

- 3) Meet with an academic advisor at both Ivy Tech Community College and Purdue University each fall and spring semester, and register for the minimum required credits for the subsequent semester.
- 4) After final grades have posted each semester, submit the official Purdue transcript to Ivy Tech via [myPurdue](#).
- 5) To continue in the program in good academic standing for the next semester, a student must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA at each institution. See below for details:

*A student who falls below a 2.5 cumulative or semester GPA at either campus during any semester will be required to develop an academic success plan in consultation with, and approved by, the Purdue University and Ivy Tech Community College advisors.**
