THE POSITION

- Provide instruction on Precision Agriculture to high school junior and senior students.

 - Remote Pilot Certification Instruction
- Course can be offered 7:45-10:15 or 11:45-2:15, M-F, 180 days per year (instructor will select time)
- NOTE: Employment is year to year and based on having sufficient enrollment.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Hold Indiana CTE: Agriculture teaching license or the ability to obtain a Workplace Specialist Teaching License
- Meet dual credit credentialing requirements through Ivy Tech Community College
- Personal characteristics of the instructor must include:
 - leadership
 - responsibility
 - goal oriented
 - self-motivation
 - effective communication skills
 - organizational skills
 - self-confidence
 - ability to relate well with others
 - maintain a positive "role model"

DUTIES

The instructor must:

- use effective classroom and laboratory management skills and practices to implement program curriculum and conduct daily classroom activities for junior and senior students.
- coordinate opportunities for students such as job shadowing and on-site visits.
- procure materials/supplies and solicit donations,
- develop and revise curriculum and supportive educational activities
- form and work with an advisory committee
- be responsible for maintenance and inventory of equipment and supplies.
- be active in the recruitment efforts of students for and promote the program in order to maintain the necessary enrollment.

- be willing to:
 - become involved in student activities within the school
 - attend workshops and conferences
