Responsibilities:

- Schedule plantings, water, cultivation, fertilizer, and/or chemical needs and harvesting.
- Complete billing of items and services to grower.
- Coordinate and communicate crop needs with farmer, company farm operators and Lead fieldsman.
- Scout crops, keeping reports on crop progress; including growth, yield checks, weeds, insects, and the controls needed to correct these problems.
- Work with growers and company farm operators to accomplish proper watering, pest, disease and weed control.
- Work with the growers to produce a quality product for them, HBI and our customer.
- Communicate with the Lead field man on a regular basis providing information on crops, weather, seed and the growers.
- Coordinate with Crop Distribution Manager, Director of Cucumber Operations and H&N Dispatchers daily on volume and crop quality.
- Comply with company and customer regulations, reporting and policies.
- Continually monitor and report field health, quality concerns or deviations to supervisory management.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Prior experience in fielding and scouting is a plus.
- Knowledge of vegetable crop production with emphasis on soils, diseases, pests, and nutrient needs.
- Candidate **MUST** be a self-motivated and detail-oriented person with high drive to be able to focus in a high tempo environment with ability to adapt to changing situations on a daily basis.
- **Must** be comfortable working outside in all weather conditions.
- Excellent communication skills, organization is key to a successful work environment.
- Bilingual skills favorable.
