- Be committed to finishing jobs

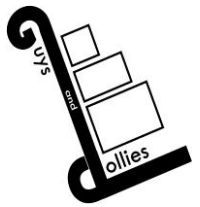
What you will gain from this internship:

Primary Responsibilities:

Logistics (50%):

- Working in a team environment to accomplish Move in and Move out weeks for students
- Learning our organization method and adapting to new ways to improve this method every year
- Developing box truck routes to make each stop the most efficient
- Strengthening the relationship between Purdue University and Guys and Dollies to conduct more contract work for the University
- Coordinating supply drop offs for customers and preparing the customers for the move out date

Recruitment/Training (20%):

- Leading effort for recruitment and scheduling during the summer months. If able to help in April, that is a plus, but not a requirement
- Scheduling and conducting on-boarding and safety training videos with new hires
- Motivating employees to complete each task and care for all items

Customer Interaction (20%):

- Provide customers the opportunity to have the best experience possible and maintain a “yes” mentality.
- Scheduling appointments with customers to meet their needs
- Implementing a follow up communication to understand how our teams performed

Marketing/Advertising (10%):

- Spreading flyers and other marketing material across high traffic areas around Purdue University and apartment complexes
- Scheduling table talks with fraternities/sororities and apartment complexes to communicate the benefits of using Guys and Dollies
- Assisting our Head of Marketing in developing and creating new marketing materials and pursuing social media advertising

Schedule and Logistics:

- We have part time availability in April and then work as soon as finals are completed until August classes start
- Very flexible on start/end times. For example, if someone can only work from April to July, we would simply try to find someone else to work from July to August.
- Hours/Vacation are also very flexible and we try to set up a summer schedule that accommodates for time off
- During the busy weeks, we do work weekends and we do work long days.
