



Repro-tech Assistant Job Description

- Livestock Veterinary Associates P.C. (LVA) is a veterinary practice providing veterinary and reproductive services to owners of cattle, goats, sheep and pigs. StockVets L.L.C. (SV) is the name of the building and property where LVA functions. Clients know this business by interchangeable names.
- Hours: 40-48 hours per week on average.
 - Monday thru Friday with some Saturdays
 - Some overnight travel as long as two weeks on the road. Estimate 30-40 nights/ year. Some Sunday travel.
- Responsibilities
 - Embryologist including searching, grading, handling and freezing embryos. There may be the opportunity to be trained to handle oocytes in the In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) work as needed.
 - Assist with shipping of semen and embryos in accordance with direction from the housing manager
 - Handle semen, embryos and liquid nitrogen in storage tanks. Work with the office staff to package and unpackage semen/ embryos for/from shipments. Record this inventory in data logs and in the computer.
 - Communicate with clients who own the animals receiving the reproductive or veterinary work via phone, email or delivery of printed reports.
 - Assist the veterinarians with medical and reproductive procedures as needed
 - Including IVF chuteside assistance when needed.
 - Surgical prep and assisting the flush procedure
 - Anesthesiology- inhalation and injectable
 - Assist with stocking supplies for reproductive work in the lab and on the trailer in preparation for trips. Maintain a functioning and clean work environment and equipment throughout the StockVets facilities and property.

- Tasks and directives as determined by the management.
