Leadership Retreat/Training	1	Participating in a leadership retreat of at least 1 day.	1	2
Application Process	1	The process of applying for a paid or unpaid position, graduate, or professional school.	1	1
Workshop	2	Typically more than 2 hours in length and requires active participation from participants.	1	4
Volunteer Experience	2	At least 1 semester in duration and must be outside of class and not required for a student organization/club/organization.	1	4
Cultural Experience	2	Mostly likely a study abroad or (intercultural) study away experience (domestic) of 3-6 weeks.	1	2
Professional Development	2	Attending a regional, national, or international conference of at least 2 days. An additional point can be earned if presenting (poster included).	1	3
Mentor	2	Serve as a mentor as part of a recognized program for at least 1 semester in duration.	1	2
Leadership Retreat/Training	2	Participating in a leadership retreat of at least 2 days. No more than 1, 2 point retreat can count overall and cannot be combined with other levels of retreats. Not to be confused with a conference.	1	2
Research	2	Can be paid or unpaid, for credit or not for credit. At least 10 hours a week conducting research. Cannot be counted as both a course and research. No more than 2 research experiences can be counted overall with 1 per category and cannot be combined with other point categories.	1	4
Internship	2	Lasting at least one semester, can be paid or unpaid, for credit or not for credit. Only 1 internship can be counted overall.	1	2
Employment	3	A paid position of at least 20 hours a week for 1 year (stay at home parenting counts). No more than 1 job can be counted. Holding a supervisory role can gain an additional point.	1	3
Cultural Experience	3	Mostly likely an independent study abroad or exchange program of at least 6 weeks. No more than 1 cultural experience can be counted overall.	1	3
Professional Development	3	Publishing a journal article in a peer reviewed journal or presenting at a professional conference/symposium (poster counts). No more than 1 article/presentation can be counted overall.	1	3
Leadership Retreat/Training	3	Participating in a leadership retreat of at least 3 days. No more than 1, 3 point retreat can count overall and cannot be combined with other levels of retreats. Not to be confused with a conference.	1	3
