



NOT COVERED


- ❖ Airfare to Dublin

Getting there

- ❖ Book your own flight
- ❖Arrive in Dublin May 20
 - ❖ Means depart US May 19
- Proposed flight
 - Currently \$1200
 - ❖ Make sure you look at what is included, not just the final price
- ❖ Meet in the Dublin Airport, Coach will pick us up there
- Coach Transport to Airport
 - Dublin Airport has US customs in Dublin[©]



Northern Ireland


- Enniskillen University Equine program

Kilkenny


