In this 4-week course, we will examine natural resources broadly defined, including forestry, fisheries, wildlife, agriculture, mining, outdoor recreation, and urban sustainability.

We will define, discover, and document examples where sustainability of resource use matters.

The course explores the effect of terrain, climate, vegetation, faunal assemblages, social structures and technologies on natural resource use.
