In this course, we will examine natural resources broadly defined, including fisheries, forestry, wildlife, agriculture, mining, outdoor recreation, and urban sustainability. During four weeks we define, discover, and document examples where sustainability of resource use matters. The course explores the effect of terrain, marine dynamics, climate, vegetation, faunal assemblages, social structures and technologies on natural resource use. The course is a collaboration of Purdue University and North Carolina State University. Students from both universities work together to explore issues in resource management.
