

## Postdoctoral Research Associate Position in Remote Sensing

### Position description:

Purdue Forest Advanced Computing & Artificial Intelligence (FACAI) Lab is seeking applicants for a Postdoctoral Research Associate Position in remote sensing. The successful candidate is expected to train and validate machine learning models to quantify and map planted forests at national and continental levels, based on in situ and remote sensing data.

Desirable starting time is May 2021, but can be flexible.

**Benefits:** The successful candidate will receive an annual compensation of ca. US\$47,500 with benefits. Initial appointment is for 12 months, with additional support available pending satisfactory performance.

**Qualifications:** A Ph.D. degree in ecology, data science, or related fields is required. Candidates will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Strong quantitative skills, and oral and writing proficiency,
- Strong research background in remote sensing
- Strong background in machine learning models for structured and unstructured data,
- Experience with using high-performance computing.
