Position description: One research assistantship at Ph.D. level is available in the area of Resource Economics and Policy, in the Department of Forestry and Natural Resources, at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana. This position will be funded by a new project aimed at assessing the effectiveness and efficiency of federal cost-share programs in controlling invasive plants in nonindustrial private forests. The incumbent is expected to start in August, 2021 or January 2022.

Qualifications: A B.S. is required and a M.S. in applied economics, natural resource policy, or statistics is preferred. Strong econometric and statistical skills and oral and writing proficiency are highly desired.
